### How much do the courses cost?

Each course costs \$450 Canadian (approximately \$400 US).

### Do I have to travel to Canada?

No, you do not have to travel to Canada. You can take this course from your own computer at home, at work, or anywhere you have Internet access.

### How do I register?

You can register for each course online, through one of the forms listed under our registration section.

### What do I do after I register online?

After you register, you will receive an email message. The email message will confirm that you are registered in the course, and it will give you instructions on how to get to the course on the Internet.

### How long are the courses?

Each course lasts for 13 weeks.

### I am very busy. When will I do my lessons?

You can study and work on the lessons any time you want to. There are no scheduled study hours for these courses. You decide when you want to work.

### What is the minimum computer configuration required to take this course?

You must be using a computer with at least: Internet Explorer 6 (or higher) or Netscape 6 (or higher), with JavaScript enabled; Windows Media Player 7 (or higher) on a PC, or QuickTime 5 (or higher) on a Macintosh; a monitor running at 800 x 600 resolution (or higher); and a modem speed of 56 kbps minimum (high speed cable/DSL is recommended).
